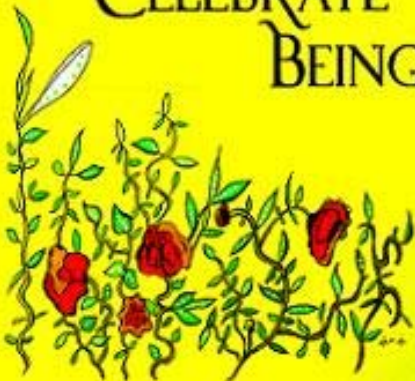

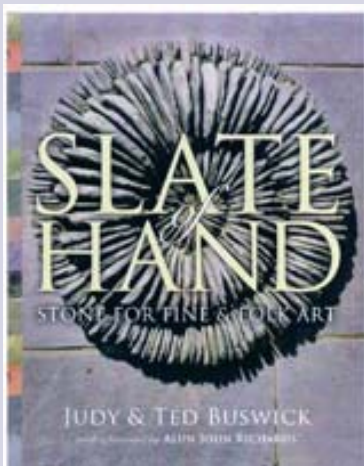
ELECTRIFYING Art-making Workshop
